

PRIVACY POLICY

Among a range of values espoused by the Portal Administrator, Logintrans sp. z o.o. based in Wysoka, the strongest emphasis was placed on ensuring the safety and satisfaction of Users of the Portal. The key to success are the actions taken by the Administrator to allow the Users to safely use the services offered within the application: goodloading.com. The Administrator shall take efforts for adequate protection of personal data provided by the Users.

Privacy Statement

This document regulates the policy applied by Logintrans Sp. z o.o located in Wysoka, at Chabrowa 4, entered in the Register of entrepreneurs kept by the District Court for Wrocław Fabryczna in Wrocław, 6th Commercial Division of the National Court Register under KRS number 0000162430, holder of NIP number: 8942764658, REGON: 932920615 (hereinafter: The Administrator) and its subcontractors and related entities, as regards to the protection of Users' personal data and information which may constitute a business secret of the Users.

This policy applies to Services offered by the Administrator via the website www.goodloading.com. It does not include third-party web sites and services which can be accessed using the links in the above-mentioned sites.

Cookies

The Administrator uses the so-called cookies to track Users' visits, to save their preferences and to adapt the services offered to them. These files are also used to compile general statistics concerning the use of the Portal by the Users. As it is possible to disable cookies in a web browser, use of the Services will not be prevented, but it can lead to some difficulties.

Data in Google Analytics

The traffic on the Administrator's sites is monitored by analytical system - Google Analytics - the aim of which is to collect data on the use of the sites and their popularity. These data (such as the browser or IP address) are never made available by the Administrator to third parties.

Data Collected

In order to use the Services offered by the Administrator, the Account must be registered via the form provided on the website or using the option to log-in with the account created earlier on one of the chosen social networks.

During the registration process, one should provide e-mail address. In addition, the User can supplement the Profile operating within its Account, with additional information, such as: full name, company name, email, telephone number, tax ID number, business address, zip code, country. The data are also collected passively, i.e. by operations of websites (e.g., IP address, resolution, the location, the type of browser).

The use of data

Contact information will be used only:

- for the purpose necessary for the execution of the agreement concluded between the User and Administrator,
- to answer the question/complaint,
- to send information bulletin of the Administrator concerning changes in the software, Regulations, etc.
- for the provision of information on the Services, if the User shows the appropriate interest.

The Administrator may use collected personal information also to send to the User - with the consent given in accordance with the provisions of the Regulations - the information on current and future products and services offered by the Administrator. This information will be sent via e-mail in the form of information or advertising campaign. However, the User may opt-out of receiving such information by sending an email to info@goodloading.com (the so-called withdrawal of consent to receive commercial information).

After the withdrawal of the consent to receive commercial information, the messages within the information bulletin concerning the changes in the software, Regulations, etc., can still be forwarded to the User.

Sharing data with other entities

The Administrator reserves the right to disclose User's personal information to its subsidiaries and entities associated with the Administrator, as well as subcontractors to the extent necessary to perform the agreement on the provision of services by electronic means. Administrator exercises reasonable care when transferring data, using measures and safeguards preventing access to the data by unauthorised persons (including SSL encrypted connections).

Without the consent of the User, the personal data shall not be shared with other third parties, except for circumstances in which the transfer occurs by a legitimate request of an authorised entity (such as law enforcement or justice authorities).

Transfer of data outside the European Community

By using the website, products or services, the User agrees to transfer personal data by the Administrator outside the European Community in order to process these data in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

Access to data

The User shall have the right to access, amend or oppose the use of his personal data. After receipt of the written request and a document certifying the identity of the User, the Administrator shall correct or delete User's personal information from the database. The Administrator shall make every reasonable effort to meet Users' requests to delete personal data, unless the data must be stored due to applicable law or lawful business objectives. The Administrator shall allow to correct most personal data by the User himself, by editing the Account.

Safety

In order to ensure the safety, the Administrator shall:

- allow the access to the Account only after entering e-mail address and password (it is recommended to set passwords, consisting of 8 characters and containing capital and small letters, special characters and numbers) that the User should keep only for himself, or through integration with User's account functioning within one of the selected social networks.
- control methods for the collection, storage and processing of information, including physical security measures to protect against unauthorised access to the system,
- grant access to personal data only to those employees, contractors and agents, who must have access to them in order to process them for Administrator; in addition, they are obliged under the agreement to maintain strict confidentiality and, in the event of non-compliance with these obligations, they may suffer the consequences, including the termination of co-operation.

Privacy Policy Statement

This Privacy Policy entered into force on 04.01.2015. The Administrator reserves the right to change this Privacy Policy, if it is necessary due to modifications in the policy or changes in management of the company, law or jurisdiction.
